Dear Parents,

I hope that this email finds you well and that your children are ready to resume online schooling in the summer term. As yet we have no firm details about the reopening of schools and we are awaiting government announcements over the next few days and weeks. We know that school is closed until at least Monday 11th May.

Over the Easter holiday, the teachers have been busy planning for the coming weeks and you will notice changes to individual class timetables. The changes reflect information gathered from the shared experiences of the teaching staff, constructive feedback that we have received from several parents, and of course the children themselves.

In order for online teaching to run as smoothly as possible, parental support is essential, especially for our younger children. The following points highlight the changes made to this term's provision:

- Updated timetables will be shared with your child.
- There will still be follow-up work set in addition to synchronous and asynchronous lessons.
- Several teachers have added suggested independent work times (homework) on the timetable to allow a daily routine to be established.
- Many children will be working in small groups in order to provide more focused lessons and greater individual participation. Some of these may be with different members of staff.
- Should the school remain closed, we will schedule online meetings with teachers in lieu of the cancelled parent-teacher meetings. Information about this will be emailed to you.

For older children, the best way for you as a parent to follow the work that is being set is to ask your child for their Campion email address and password. This is a school account for schoolwork and should not contain any personal or sensitive information that your child might not wish to share with you. Therefore, they should not have any reason for not sharing their Campion School password with you.

I would like to thank you all for your support so far. As we move forward it is vital that we work together to maintain a balance between academic and emotional support for the children. Whilst we believe that academic development is important we should not underestimate the emotional stress that children and, of course, parents are undergoing. This may increase as some of you begin to return to work over the coming weeks and childcare becomes increasingly difficult. Therefore, I would urge you all to be proactive in contacting class teachers via their school email if you have any concerns at all about your child over the coming weeks.

Once your child gets used to the new timetables, I invite you to complete a second survey asking any questions that you may have.
