Dear Parents,

I hope you and your families are all safe and well.

The Year 13 students have now submitted all their coursework according to the IB requirements introduced after the recent school closures and must now complete their CAS reflections and finalise their university choices. There are still several items to be completed which I have listed below, and I ask that students check their emails regularly to ensure they complete necessary paperwork and meet deadlines.

With respect to IB results, the IBO has **not** issued any further information to schools, since my last email to you, concerning the awarding of grades. The paragraph below is what you will currently find on the official IB website:

“We will be using vast historical assessment data to ensure that we follow a rigorous process of due diligence in what is a truly unprecedented situation. We will be undertaking significant data analysis from previous exam sessions, individual school data, subject data as well as comparative data of schools who have already completed uploading requirements and those who have not.

We will award each student a grade for each of the registered subjects using a calculation that takes into account student’s coursework marks and their predicted grade, as submitted to the IB by their school. For most components we will externally mark work that is usually marked by teachers, instead of taking samples and applying moderation.”

There are still a few things to complete before the official summer holiday begins:

CAS. Students must maintain contact with Mrs Andrianaki and their CAS supervisors and ensure they meet the deadline of **10th May**. As you know, completion of CAS is one of the requirements for the award of a Diploma.

Firm and Insurance Choices. Students must keep in touch with Mrs Misirli about their firm and insurance choice of universities and ensure that they **confirm their places by the UCAS deadline**. Any student intending to study outside of the UK, must keep both Mrs Misirli and myself informed.

Release of Results permission letter. In a few weeks’ time I will be in touch with all of Year 13, once they have decided on their firm and insurance choices, regarding the release of IB results to universities. Students will be asked to complete, sign and return a form to me and I will upload the necessary information to the IB website. Again, students must check their emails regularly.

Legalisation of IB Results. Several countries require the legalisation of the IB Programme results documentation including Cyprus, Czech Republic, Greece, Italy, Israel, Malta, Spain, Serbia, and some universities in Holland (this is not the full list). If students do not intend to study in the UK please check

with universities, before **10th May** if the legalisation of IB results is required. The IB charges a fee of €119 for this service (which includes courier delivery).

Visas. Students must ensure they meet any visa requirements. Please speak with Mrs Misirli and contact universities to ensure compliance.

Isotimeia. Mrs Meidana has been in touch with those students intending to sit this equivalency exam and she will keep you up-to-date on dates/times of the exams. Again, students must check emails regularly.

Please feel free to contact me with any questions, and I look forward to seeing you and your children on 5th July when you can collect results from school.
