



Press Release: IB Results, 5th July 2021

This has been a very challenging year for all pupils and the significant disruption to education has been felt most keenly by those who should have taken their final exams this summer – they only received nine weeks of face-to-face teaching throughout the whole year! Campion has a long track record of academic excellence and this year, despite the difficulties faced and pupils being placed on the IB Diploma non-exam route, is no different.

We are continually amazed by the resilience and perseverance shown by our students in such challenging circumstances. As a cohort, the average points score of 39, (9 points above the 2019 world average) is phenomenal and a Campion record. We are also delighted that 100% of pupils who sat the diploma were successful.
