We seek to appoint a lab technician to work in the Science department. They will be tasked with supporting teaching staff in the preparation and cleaning of lesson materials by ensuring that all equipment requisitions are completed to the highest standards and that all laboratories and storage spaces are safe and in good order.

We have a strong Science department that works collaboratively and is fully supportive of both staff and students. The successful candidate will work closely with the science team, sharing their passion for the students learning journey. They should be dedicated to education and invest time in order to develop their practice with a desire to become part of the Campion community.
